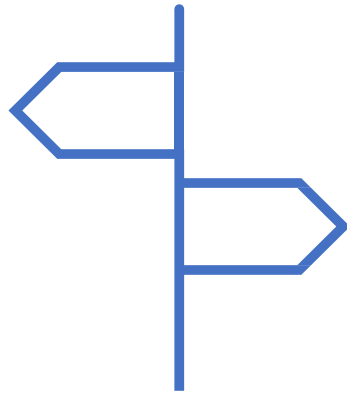

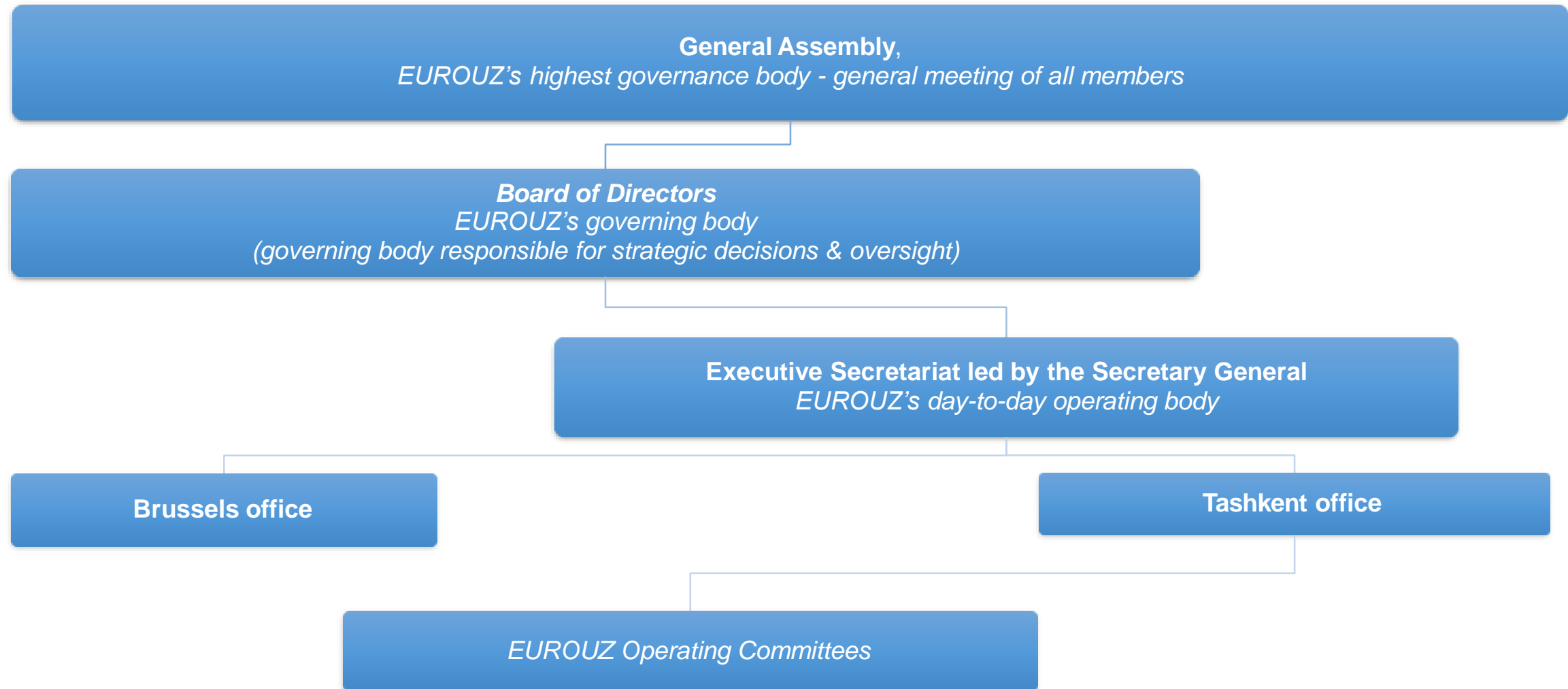

Who can become a member of EUROUZ ?

- All members must have a legal establishment or tax residents either in Uzbekistan or the European Union, the European Free Trade Association, Switzerland or the United Kingdom.
- All members of EUROUZ share the goal of supporting the development of further collaboration between the European economic region and Uzbekistan.
- Only legal persons (organizations) can become members of EUROUZ.
